1600 Sundowners Deanbilla

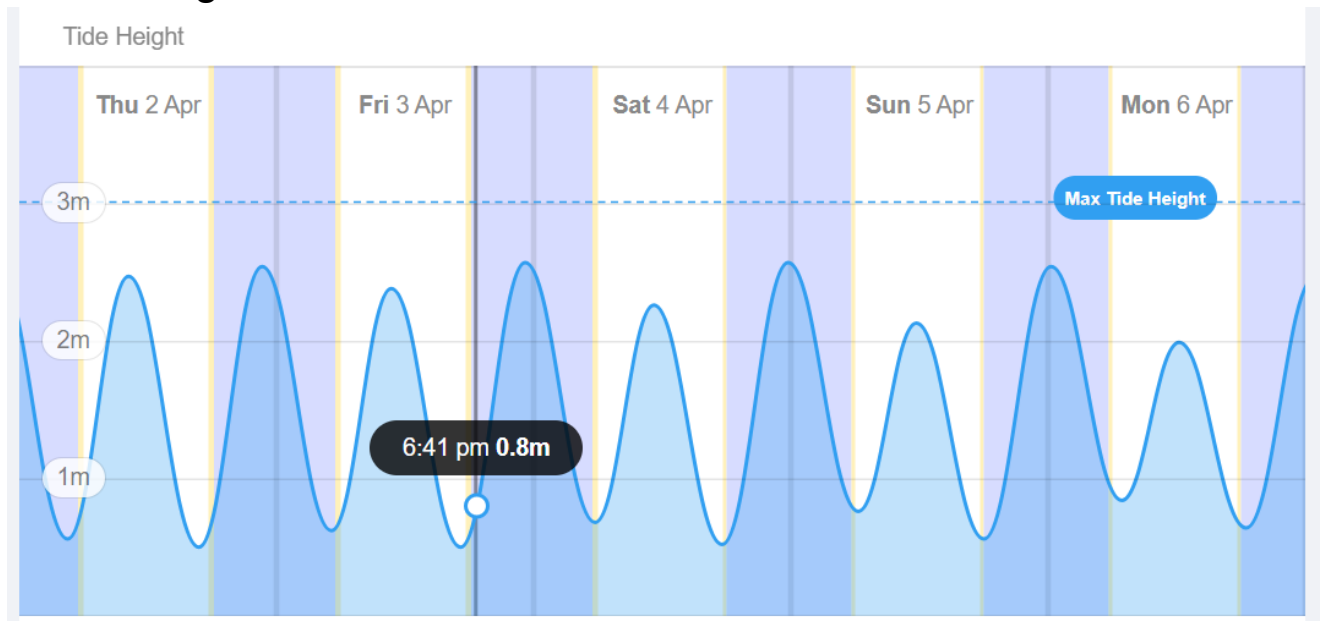
